





AGE PROFILE

Floor Covering Installers have a smaller share of youth (under age 25) compared to other Red Seal trades and all occupations.

Approximately a fifth (21%) of Floor Covering Installers are nearing the age of retirement (age 55 or over).

EDUCATION PATHWAY

Floor Covering Installer is a non-compulsory trade in Ontario, which does not require certification or registration as an apprentice to practice within the province.

A grade 10 education is required to qualify for an apprenticeship.

The apprenticeship program is approximately three and a half years, consisting of 5,400 hours of on-the-job work experience and 2 levels of in-school training.

In addition to holding a Certificate of Qualification, approximately 20% of Floor Covering Installers also hold a postsecondary credential.
