Implementation Plan	 All apprentices with initial training agreements registered on or after must be trained to the new curriculum. On or after Tuesday September 6th, 2022, any apprentice who loses his or her training standard must be trained to and completed with the new standard even if they began their apprenticeship with the previous versions. 				
Impact on the Curriculum Standard	 The current Curriculum Standard for 441C is posted to the Skilled Trades Ontario website. A new curriculum has been revised to be harmonized to complement the new Training Standard. This will be released at date to be determined. The new Horticultural Technician Training Standard is harmonized with the Red Seal Occupational Standard (2017). 				
Training Standard Access	 On the job as of: Tuesday September 6th, 2022 The new Logbook will be available on the Skilled Trades Ontario website. Apprentices who register in 441C Horticultural Technician trade will be sent a printed Logbook. If the apprentice wants a copy of the Logbook before receiving the printed copy in the mail, the apprentice can download/print a copy from the Skilled Trades Ontario website. 				
Format Changes	The content and structure of the Horticultural Technician on-the-job training standard has been significantly revised as a part of the process to harmonize with the Landscape Horticulturist, Red Seal Occupational Standard (RSOS). It includes 4 sections, Trade Foundational Skills, Apply Horticultural Principles, Performs Landscape Construction and Performs Landscape Maintenance.

Content changes Skills Added

The content of the Horticultural Technician Training Standard was revised significantly to be harmonized with the 2017 Red Seal Occupational Standard for the Trade of Landscape Horticulturist.

The Horticultural Technician trade promotes and practices sustainable landscape horticulture. With an increased global awareness of the environment, climate change, and health and wellness, the public is seeking the leadership of the trade to conserve, protect, and enhance ecosystems and living spaces. As such, the principles and practices of landscape and horticulture and environmental stewardship are the foundation of this document and are imbedded in the competencies required by an apprentice to complete the program. Applying horticultural practices and using sound environmental practices are emphasized throughout the standard.

The practices of environmental stewardship, biodiversity enhancement and soil and water stewardship are incorporated into new skills in 9297: Apply Environmental Practices. These include:

- o **9297.03** Select and maintain tools and equipment
- 0 9297.04 Use practices to integrate on-site elements
- o **9297.05** Select plants such as natives and edibles

Optional skills within Install Green Infrastructure Systems (9302) and Maintain Green Infrastructure (9305) were also added to support the focus on environmental practices.

General Notes & Rationale

Applying horticultural practices and using sound environmental practices are emphasised throughout the standard. More attention is paid to plant health as the expectation is that this starts at the design phase and carries through to construction and maintenance. Water optimization, conservation and protection, the use of native and natural materials and green infrastructure and using tools and equipment that produce fewer emissions and reduce noise and vibration are all part of this focus.

The demand for specialized skilled workers in the landscape horticulture trade is growing, the work is becoming more intricate because of the complexity of the designs and expanding customer requests for outdoor rooms, organic horticulture and sustainable design. In addition, government is looking to the industry to provide guidance regarding the optimization, conservation, capture and recycling of water. And the industry is also trending from seasonal work to full-time employment opportunities. The new optional skills included in the standard reflect these changes in the sector.
