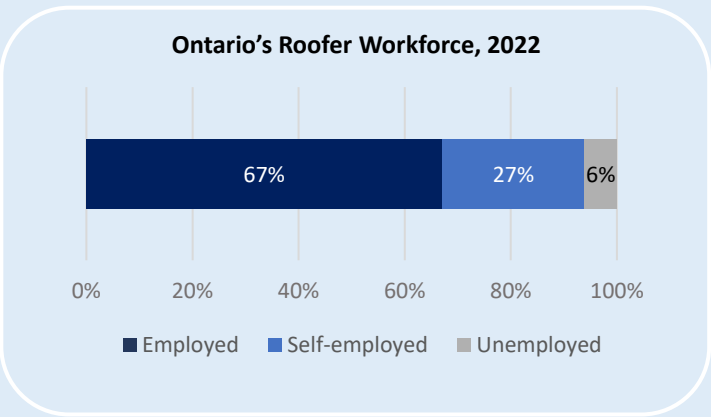


Roofer (449A)

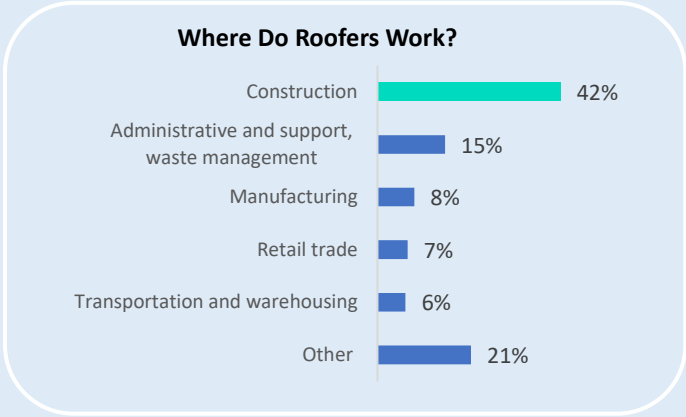


Roofers install, repair or replace flat roofs as well as shingles, shakes or other roofing tiles on sloped roofs. They work with a variety of materials with different application methods, including slate, roofing tiles and membrane systems. 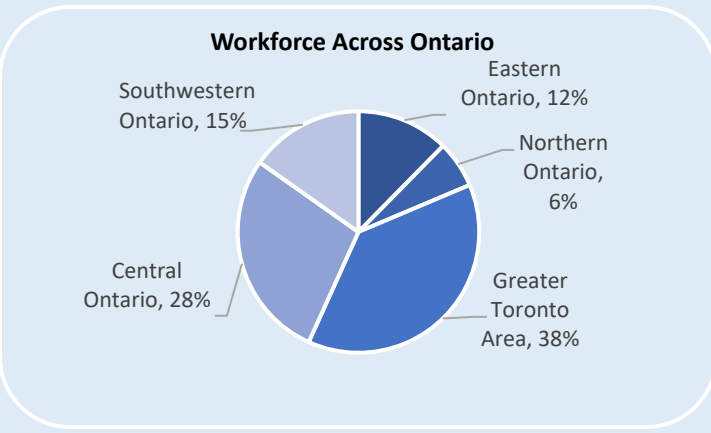

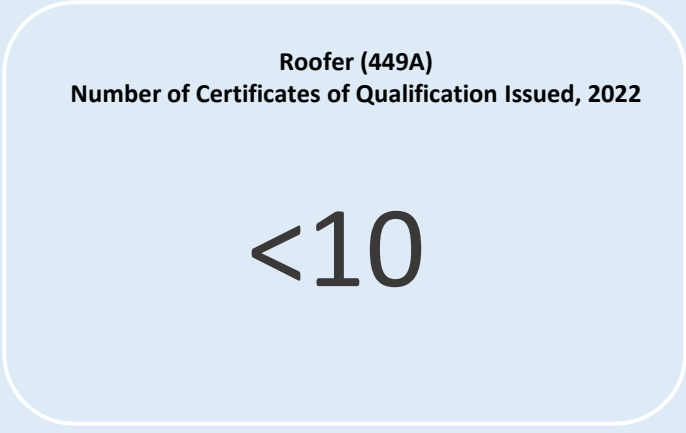

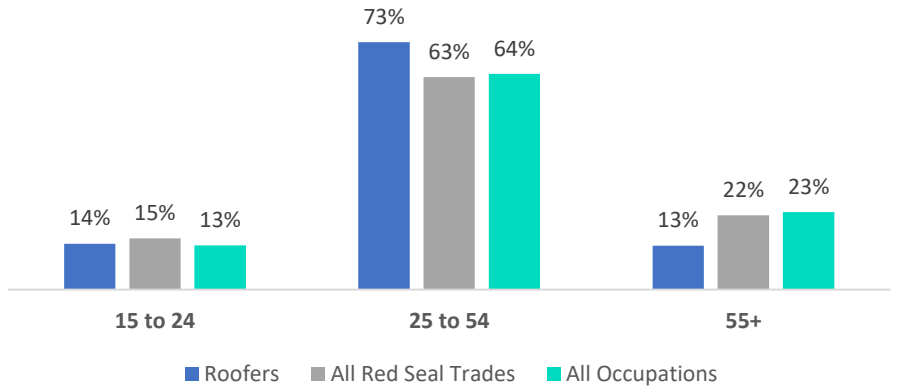

EDUCATION PATHWAY

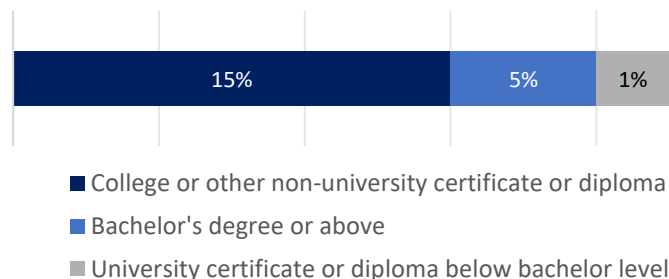
Roofer is a non-compulsory trade in Ontario, which does not require certification or registration as an apprentice to practice within the province.

A grade 10 education is required to qualify for an apprenticeship.

The apprenticeship program is approximately two years, consisting of 3,520 hours of on-the-job work experience and 2 levels of in-school training.
