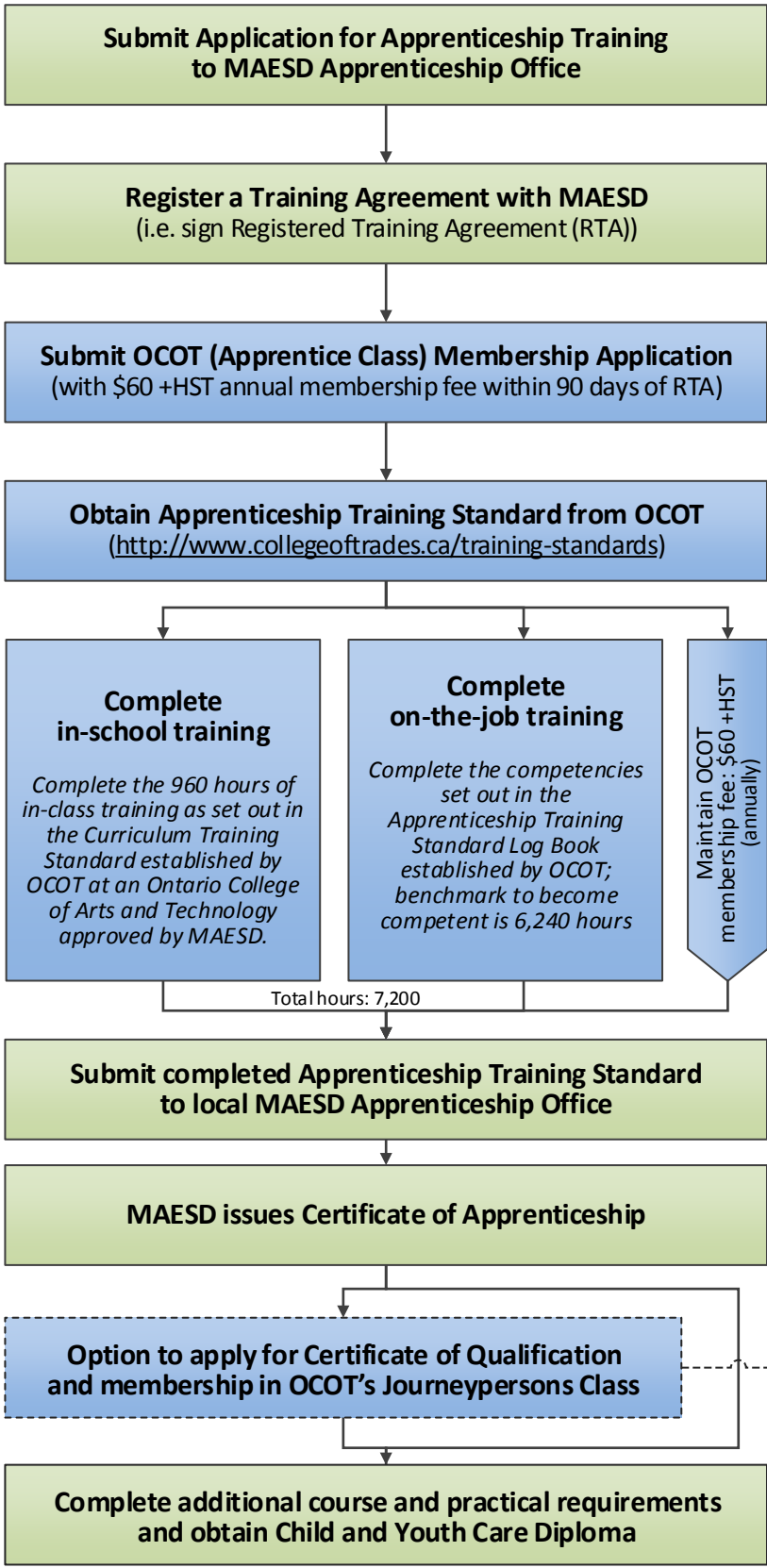

Note: Diploma requirements vary depending on the Ontario College of Applied Arts and Technology program; in general, bridging should be done at the same College where in-school apprenticeship training was completed.

** Eligible employers with apprentices registered to training agreements with the ministry on or before November 14, 2017, continue to be eligible for the Apprenticeship Training Tax Credit (ATTC) in select trades. Effective November 15, 2017, the ATTC has been replaced by a new Graduated Apprenticeship Grant for Employers (GAGE). *** Effective November 15, 2017, there have been changes to the Apprenticeship Completion Employer Bonus. Employers eligible for GAGE are not eligible for the employer completion bonus. Employers in trades not eligible for GAGE are eligible for the completion bonus. *Please note, Child and Youth Worker is not GAGE eligible.*
